

What is a Ouilt Trail?

It's an imaginary clothesline of interconnecting barns and other buildings, decorated with guilt squares and painted by women across the landscape. There are quilt trails in many places in the US, and it is our vision to include Mendocino County.

What does a Barn Quilt look like?

They are attractively painted quilt squares, from a choice of designs and colors, placed at your own business, home, barn, building, or other place you might want to hang one.



Where are Ouilt Trails?

There are Quilt Trails in over 43 states and three Canadian provinces. Together they create a large network of trails, with well over 3000 barn quilts just waiting to be discovered.

How To Get Started
